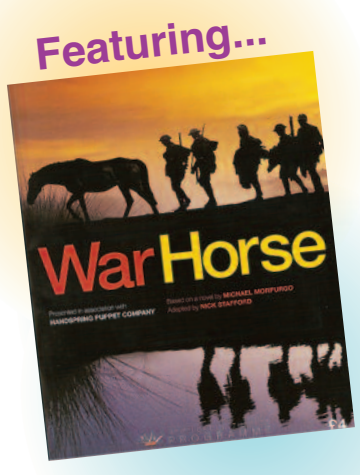

## LONDON ITINERARY

This is only a SAMPLE itinerary. A final itinerary will be issued approximately 30 days prior to departure.

### Sunday April 29

We will be departing from San Diego in the evening on a British Airways non-stop overnight flight to London's Heathrow Airport.

### Monday April 30

Arrival at London's Heathrow Airport in the morning, London time, and transfer by coach to the first-class Millennium Gloucester Hotel, located just a few blocks from Hyde Park and Kensington Gardens. After check-in, you'll have a short orientation meeting along with some refreshing tea and biscuits. The afternoon will be free to either rest a bit or wander out and take in some of the local sights such as Kensington Gardens, Hyde Park or maybe visit the Victoria and Albert Museum, just a few blocks away. In the evening we will be going by coach to the West End for our welcome dinner at Sarastros Restaurant.

### Tuesday May 1

This morning we will be taken on a private coach tour of London to get up to snuff with the layout of the city and view some of its major sites. Over the past decade, London's redevelopment has emerged as one of the most inventive in the world and most all has been centered on the River Thames. This snaking waterway has seen massive changes along its historic path beginning at the turn of the 21st Century with the Millennium events in Greenwich. From the Southbank to the Docklands, the new London Eye and the amazing re-construction of the suburb of Stratford in preparation for the 2012 Summer Olympics, London has changed like never before. In the afternoon, we will be visiting the Shakespeare's Globe Theatre and Exhibition for a guided tour. Tonight, our first show will be the Royal National Theatre's award-winning production of **WAR HORSE**, now performing on London's West End.

### Wednesday May 2

In the morning, we will divide into small touring groups for our own personalized tour of London. Our Blue Badge Guides are quite impressive. Awarded by the Institute of Tourist Guiding, the Blue Badge is the highest guiding qualification in Britain. They are an incredible wealth of knowledge on history, fine arts, architecture and just about every subject one could imagine. We'll have the opportunity of choosing from a number of tours: The City, Legal London, London Parks, Shakespeare's London, The West End or even Off-The-Beaten-Path. In the afternoon, we will be taking a backstage tour of one of London most beautiful theatres, Theatre Royal – Drury Lane. Tonight's performance will be the Royal Shakespeare's production of the acclaimed new musical, **MATILDA**.

### Thursday May 3

A visit to Windsor Castle is scheduled for today. Located just outside London, Windsor Castle is the largest inhabited castle in the world. It is the Queen's official residence and was built by William the Conqueror in 1066 after his victory at the battle of Hastings. The castle was closed to visitors after the devastating fire of 1992. After a \$63 million renovation, it re-opened in 1997. The damaged rooms gleam with gold gilt, sparkling chandeliers and silk damask wall coverings; and more parts of the castle are now open to the public than before the blaze. Viewing this magnificent castle will be quite a treat. Tonight's show will be the award-winning musical direct from the Chichester Festival, **SINGIN' IN THE RAIN**.

### Friday May 4

This morning we'll begin our day with a canal cruise along one of the most lovely areas of London, Little Venice. This picturesque pool of water, where the Grand Union and Regent's Canals meet, is home to a number of waterside cafes, pubs and eateries. From here we will take a canal boat trip and see how the winding waterway snakes its way through the heart of the city downstream past the charming regency streets and on to Regent's Park and Camden Locks. In the afternoon, we'll be taking a walking tour of the site of the upcoming 2012 London Olympics. The London 2012 Games are the catalyst for transforming a vast swath of land in east London. What was once industrial, contaminated land has been rapidly transformed over the past three years. The Olympic Park will create a green backdrop for the Games and a new green space after 2012 for people and wildlife living in and around the area to enjoy. Upon returning to the hotel, afternoon tea will be served along with a theatre discussion by a leading theatre personality. This evening is free.

### Saturday May 5

This morning, there will be a backstage tour of the Royal National Theatre. The afternoon can be set aside for some of London's wonderful museums. Visit the British Museum's Egyptian collection, the new "Tate Modern" along the Thames, or the Victoria & Albert Museum's grand costume section. In the evening we will be seeing a new production at the Royal National Theatre. (TBA)

### Sunday May 6

We will be departing in the afternoon for our non-stop British Airways flight from Heathrow Airport back to San Diego.

**NOTE:** The cost of the tour does NOT include U.S. and British government airline taxes and any airline fuel surcharges. Currently these total charges are approximately \$580.
